

Collage Concert Ensemble Auditions

On Wednesday, December 5th and Thursday, December 6th, the PCHS Music Department will proudly present our Collage Concert, our annual holiday themed concert. There is an opportunity for vocal students to audition for a few performance slots for both concerts. This would be a great opportunity for any soloists, duets or small ensembles to be showcased for the performance.

A list of audition guidelines are below:

1. This is a holiday concert, so your music selection needs to reflect that. In order to audition, you must confirm what your audition piece is with me, to make sure that we are not performing the same piece twice in the concert. You also must have sheet music for your audition. I have holiday pieces in the choral library, as well as books for you to go through, but you are not limited to just those options. Websites like **sheetmusicplus.com** or **musicnotes.com** are great places to find pieces, especially if you're looking to do more recent holiday covers.
2. You must figure out accompaniment and have it prepared for your audition. Accompaniment that is acceptable could be piano, guitar, or ukulele. Backing tracks off of YouTube are not acceptable.
3. Preparation for the auditions are entirely on you. If you are preparing a selection in a small group, you need to figure out how you will rehearse. Class time will not be an option to rehearse, but practice rooms are open during 4th period, 6th period and after school.
4. Auditions will be held on Monday, November 19th, starting at 3:00pm in the choir room. In order to audition, you must sign up for a time slot and complete the audition handout. Make sure to pay attention to the checklist on the audition handout. Any incomplete handout will result in the audition not being heard.
