What is Tri-M?

Tri-M, also known as Modern Music Masters, is a Music Honor Society associated with the National Association for Music Education (NAfME). Its goal is to inspire students to be involved in their school and community, build leadership characteristics, spark creativity, and reward its members with outstanding experiences through volunteerism.

What are the requirements to be accepted into Tri-M?

Students who are interested in being a part of Tri-M must complete an application.

Some requirements to be eligible into application process:

- Must be enrolled in a music class for the academic year
- *(after school ensembles do not count as a class!)*
- Must have a minimum A grade in music class.
- Must have a minimum B grade average overall in all other classes, or a weighted 4.0
 - Must have a minimum C grade average in weighted courses

After students fulfill these requirements they must fill out an *application and receive two recommendations*.

Students accepted into the PCHS Tri-M chapter are required to pay annual dues of \$30. Dues must be paid prior to the Member Induction Ceremony on Thursday, October 3rd.

Please note: all students must apply annually except for elected executive board members.

How will I know if I am accepted?

Students will find out if they were accepted into Tri-M by email, an acceptance letter, or finding their ID numbers listed on all who made it into Tri-M, in the music hallway.

Following the acceptance, students will be required to attend an induction making them official Tri-M members.

What happens when I become a member?

Once Tri-M members, students will be required to attend monthly meetings as well as complete 10 service hours per semester. Students will regularly be provided with opportunities to complete these hours. Tri-M may also take on additional opportunities to serve our community as they become available throughout the year.
